## Patio Fire Pit Kit Assembly Instructions

110 **SOLID** Granite Tiles Metal Bowl Insert

## Additional materials needed:

Tape Measure Level High Heat Silicone Adhesive (optional)

**Step 1:** Decide on your Fire Pit location. Make sure it's level and clear of vegetation.

**Step 2:** Decide on your 11 Capstones and place to the side for the final row. You can choose to make your capstones all one type of granite to compliment your decor or create a beautiful mosaic with your favorite pieces.

**Step 3:** Start building your Fire Pit. The interior circumference is 28". Lay-out your first row of 11 Granite Tiles and check for level and proper spacing. After that its easy, just build one row after the other. Occasionally check that your spacing is equal and you're maintaining a level build.

**Step 4:** Secure the final 2 rows using a high heat adhesive\*(optional). Allow adhesive to cure completely before using Fire Pit. The completed Granite Fire Pit weighs approximately 900lbs. \*Follow manufacturers instructions since drying time will vary per product.

**Step 5:** Enjoy! Granite is one of natures most durable and beautiful stones. Your Fire Pit is sure to delight for many, many years to come.

Check with local zoning codes for proper positioning next to structures. This Fire Pit is considered non-permanent.
